The Proper Officer is the Returning Officer, Town Hall, Sankey Street, Warrington, WA1 1UH.

If an Election is not requested, the Parish Council shall fill the vacancy by co-option.

¹ In computing any period of time for the purposes of this notice a Saturday, Sunday, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday or day appointed for public thanksgiving or mourning, shall be <u>disregarded</u>.

² If an election is triggered by 10 electors, paragraph 6(2) of the 2020 Regulations applies and a poll to fill the casual vacancy does not take place. Instead the vacancy is filled at the ordinary election on 6 May 2021.
